In UCD-CSC 2011 Scheme, there are essentially two schemes:

- 4 year full UCD student Scholarship Scheme where the student gets a UCD degree
- 'joint'/visiting arrangement where the student visits UCD under the supervision of a UCD member of staff for a period of time, minimum 6 months max 24 months

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants to the UCD-CSC Scholarship Scheme 2011 must be:

- Citizens and permanent residents (under 35 years' old) of the People's Republic of China at the time of application;
- Candidates who are not currently working or studying abroad;
- Enrolled as a full-time post graduate student (including the first year of PhD programmes) in the universities specified;
- Outstanding final year undergraduate students currently studying at the universities specified.
- Candidates who satisfy the selection criteria set out by the CSC by completing the CSC Application form and the CSC Employer Reference Form at <http://apply.csc.edu.cn/>

AWARD

If selected as a recipient, the student will receive the award from UCD for his/her tuition fee and the award from the CSC for his/her living expenses and airfares.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

- The academic transcript;
- The proof of English language level i.e. IELTS, TOEFL etc.;
- The degree certificate;
- Two references.

* Applications that are late or incomplete will automatically be disqualified.
